

Rulemaking* Process

Rules Comm receives request for rulemaking. Rules Comm prepares draft rule and forwards to Exec Comm as a recommendation or explanation of non-recommendation.

Exec Comm accepts recommendation for presentation to Commission; accepts non-recommendation; or returns to Rules Comm for amendments.

Proposed rule published on Commission website and to delegates for comments

Rules Comm reviews all comments and revises rule if needed. Member States and Commission posts final proposed rule 30 days before meeting where it will be voted. Public hearing will be held if hearing requirement is triggered pursuant to Sec. 10 of Compact and Rule on Rulemaking

Commission votes on rule at least 30 days after posting. No amendments are accepted from the floor. Commission sets effective date. Votes must be a simple majority to pass. Rules may be consolidated for hearings.
