**Welcome/Call to Order**

- G. Thornton called the meeting to order at 2:34 PM ET.

**Roll Call**

- I. Eliassen called the roll. Mike Zagarella was absent.

**Review and Adoption of Agenda**

- G. Thornton asked if there were any questions about the agenda. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to adopt the agenda.
- **Motion:** C. Covert-ByBee moved that the ASLP-IC Rules Committee adopt the agenda. N. Brown seconded the motion. All Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

**Review and Adopt Minutes**

- G. Thornton asked if there were any questions about the July minutes.
- G. Thornton asked for a motion to adopt the minutes.
- **Motion:** S. Smith moved that the Rules Committee adopt the June minutes as amended. N. Brown seconded the motion. All Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

**Discussion and Approval of Recommended Rules\***

- G. Thornton indicated the Committee would continue to review draft rules from the last meeting.

**“Deactivate”**

- C. Covert-ByBee and N. Brown asked about how the term deactivate is used by the Commission and the differentiation between member state home license and single state home license.
- The Committee agreed to further discuss deactivate in coordination with home state license.

**“Disqualifying Event”**

- C. Covert-ByBee asked where this term occurs in the model language.
- N. Kalfas suggested that what constitutes a disqualifying event should be an FAQ.
- The Committee determined that this can be revisited when needed.

**“Encumbrance”**

- C. Covert-ByBee indicated that revocation or suspension are two of many encumbrances. She suggested that we broaden the definition to that similar to the PT Compact.
- N. Brown suggested that including this may cause confusion as to what actions are disciplinary vs. non-disciplinary actions for each state.
- S. Smith suggested using the original draft definition without revocation and suspension.

- The Committee also discussed temporary licenses or time limited temporary military licenses were considered encumbrances. A license with supervision requirements is not unrestricted. An FAQ should be created to further clarify.

“Initial Compact Privilege”

- I. Eliassen suggested renaming to “Initial Privilege to Practice” to reflect the term in the compact.
- The Committee discussed whether the term needed to be further defined. N. Kalfas indicated that this could be addressed at a later date if needed or discussed in a FAQ.
- I. Eliassen mentioned that other compacts have only one initial privilege to practice but this compact is written differently. C. Covert-ByBee indicated that there should be a rule to avoid states being out of compliance.
- The Committee discussed the requirement for the FBI background check and initial privilege to practice.
- The Committee decided to table the discussion of this definition and the “home state license” until the next committee meeting.

- G. Thornton asked if there was any additional business. Seeing none, G. Thornton asked for a motion to adjourn the Rules Committee meeting.
