**Welcome/Call to Order**

- G. Thornton called the meeting to order at 2:32 PM ET.

**Roll Call**

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- I. Eliassen called the roll.

**Review and Adoption of Agenda**

- G. Thornton asked if there were any questions about the agenda. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to adopt the agenda.
- **Motion:** M. Zagarella moved that the ASLP-IC Rules Committee adopt the agenda. S. Smith seconded the motion. All Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

**Review and Adopt Minutes**

- G. Thornton asked if there were any questions about the August minutes.
- G. Thornton asked for a motion to adopt the minutes.
- **Motion:** S. Smith moved that the Rules Committee adopt the August minutes. M. Zagarella seconded the motion. All Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

**Discussion and Approval of Recommended Rules\***

- G. Thornton indicated the Committee would continue to review draft rules from the last meeting.

**“Initial Privilege to Practice”**

- C. Covert-ByBee submitted comments suggesting the Committee table this definition indefinitely or until it is deemed necessary.
- After Committee discussion, G. Thornton indicated the current definition can remain as written.

**“Home State License”**

- C. Covert-ByBee submitted comments suggesting the Committee include a definition of “primary state of residence”
- C. Covert-ByBee also made suggestions for clarity.

**“Primary State of Residence”**

- The Committee recommended including the Primary State of Residence (PSOR) definition that is included in the Occupational Therapy Licensure Compact.
- “Primary State of Residence” means the state (also known as the Home State) in which an Audiologist or Speech-Language Pathologist who is not Active Duty Military declares a primary residence for legal purposes as verified by: driver’s license, federal income tax return, lease, deed, mortgage or voter registration or other verifying documentation as further defined by Commission Rules.
- N. Brown suggested it be both a rule and a FAQ.

**“Deactivate”**

- C. Covert-ByBee submitted comments suggesting that the definition “deactivate” be further defined.

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- The Commission decided to revise the definition to reflect the reporting of the change of status and to create a FAQ to expand on the situations where this may occur.
- M. Zagarella asked about Section 4F. N. Kalfas indicated that should be included in the FAQ.
- G. Thornton indicated the Committee had completed the rules discussion. A further discussion was held on by-laws amendments that were recommended from the June 9, 2022 meeting.
- **Motion:** S. Smith moved to approve the revised definition to send to the Executive Committee along with a note that FAQs will be developed and to send the already approved bylaw amendments to the Executive Committee. N. Brown seconded the motion. All Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.
