15 **Reason for Rule:** To establish fees for the application for a privilege to practice pursuant to
16 **Section 8.E.3.a.** and **Section 8.E.8.c** of the ASLP-IC.

23 **Chapter 4:** Rulemaking on Fees

25 **Authority:** **Section 3:** State Participation in the Compact

27 **Section 8:** Establishment of the Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology Interstate

30 **Section 10:** Rulemaking

32 **Purpose:** Pursuant to **Section 3.J.**, member states may charge a fee for granting a compact
33 privilege.

34
35 Pursuant to **Section 8.E.3.a.**, the Executive Committee shall have the following duties
36 and responsibilities: Recommend to the entire Commission changes to the rules or
37 bylaws, changes to this Compact legislation, fees paid by Compact member states
38 such as annual dues, and any commission Compact fee charged to licensees for the
39 compact privilege;

40

41 Pursuant to **Section 8.E.8.c**, the Commission may levy on and collect an annual
42 assessment from each member state or impose fees on other parties to cover the cost
43 of the operations and activities of the Commission and its staff, which must be in a
44 total amount sufficient to cover its annual budget as approved each year for which
45 revenue is not provided by other sources. The aggregate annual assessment amount
46 shall be allocated based upon a formula to be determined by the Commission, which
47 shall promulgate a rule binding upon all member states.

49 **4.1 Definitions:**

50 “Commission Administrative Fee” means a fee paid as part of a Privilege to Practice
51 request and paid to the Commission.

52

53 “State Fee” means a non-refundable fee established by each individual Member
54 State. The fee is collected by the Commission and forwarded to the Member State.

55

56 **4.2 Commission Administrative Fees:**

57 A non-refundable Commission Administrative Fee of \$50.00 (fifty USD) shall be paid
58 by the licensee to the Commission for each state in which a Privilege to Practice that
59 is requested in addition to each individual State’s Fee.

60

61 The Commission Administrative Fee is subject to change through the Rulemaking
62 authority of the Commission.

63

64 **4.3 State Fees:**

65 Member States may establish their State Fee in accordance with the Member State’s
66 required processes to be paid by the licensee to the Commission.

67

68 The Commission shall remit to the Member State 100% (one hundred percent) of the
69 State Fee on a basis as established in this Rule.

70

71 State Fees may be changed by the Member State with 30 (thirty) days’ notice of
72 intent to the Commission to change the fee in accordance with the Member State’s
73 required processes. The notice shall be posted to the Member State’s website and
74 the Commission website.

75

76 **4.4 Acceptable Forms of Payment for Administrative and State Fees:**

77 The Commission Administrative Fee and any applicable State Fee shall be remitted
78 electronically via the Commission’s databank system. Payment of fees submitted
79 through the mail will not be accepted.

80

81 **4.5 Delegation of Collection and Disbursement of Fees:**

82 On its behalf and on behalf of the Member State, the Commission shall provide and
83 administer a process to collect Commission Administrative Fees and State Fees from
84 licensees. The Commission shall remit the collected fees to the Member States in
85 accordance with the provisions of this rule.

86
87 The Commission shall provide an itemization sufficient to permit the Member State
88 to reconcile the fees.

89
90 The Commission shall effectuate fund disbursement of collected Member State Fees
91 starting on the 15th of the month after which the fee was collected.

92
93 **4.6 Failed Payments**

94 A non-refundable service fee of \$100.00 may be imposed on an individual who
95 submits an electronic payment to the Commission for administrative or state fees
96 without sufficient funds in the payer's account. 100% (one hundred percent) of the
97 fee shall be deposited in the Commission's general fund to cover costs incurred in
98 attempting to recover failed payment transaction(s).
