**Welcome/Call to Order**

G. Thornton called the Rules Committee (Committee) meeting to order at 3:02 PM ET.

**Roll Call**

L. Edwards-Gaither called the roll.

**Review and Adopt Agenda**

G. Thornton asked if there were any questions or points of discussion about the agenda. Hearing none, G. Thornton asked for a motion to adopt the agenda.

**Motion:** T. Cranfill moved to adopt Rules Committee agenda. M. Zagarella seconded the motion. All Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

**Review and Adopt Minutes**

G. Thornton asked if there were any questions or points of discussion about the June 12, 2025, meeting minutes. C. Covert-Bybee asked that the June 12, 2025 draft minutes be revised to reflect the Rules Committee's approval the draft FAQs to be posted to the ASLP-IC Website. K. Buckhout and L. Edwards-Gaither will revise the June 12, 2025 minutes accordingly and post the revised and adopted minutes to the ASLP-IC Website. G. Thornton asked for a motion to adopt the minutes.

**Motion:** M. Zagarella moved that the Rules Committee adopt the June 12, 2025, meeting minutes with the requested revision by C. Covert-Bybee. T. Cranfill seconded the motion. All delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

**Update to Draft Amendment to ASLP-IC Rule on Fees**

G. Thornton shared that the ASLP-IC Rule on Fees was adopted at the Special Commission Meeting on June 30, 2025. This rule sets the commission administrative fee for an application for a compact privilege to practice at \$50. Additionally, K. Buckhout shared that the amendment to the ASLP-IC Rule on

Criminal Background Check Implementation was adopted at the Special Commission Meeting on June 30, 2025. This amendment supports member states with activation of the compact to allow for issuance and acceptance of privileges to practice in the event member states face delays or barriers to getting ORI numbers which enables full implementation of a national criminal background check program.

#### **Review of Drafted Website FAQs**

L. Edwards-Gaither shared that the FAQs developed and approved by the Committee at the June 12 meeting have been posted to the ASLP-IC Website. G. Thornton shared that FAQs will be further discussed and developed at future Rules Committee Meetings.

#### **Discussion of Future Business and Potential New Rules\***

G. Thornton opened discussion of drafting a rule to define/clarify that the length of time for the supervised postgraduate professional experience shall be a minimum of 36 weeks. The Committee agreed to table discussion until further data and information can be gathered about how member states are addressing supervised postgraduate professional experience in their own rules, regulations and practice acts.

G. Thornton opened a discussion on an amendment to the ASLP-IC Rule on Data Set Reporting Requirements. G. Thornton explained the rule needs to be amended to remove “or National Provider Identifier (NPI)” from Chapter 2.1 Section B(1)(f). The Committee also discussed revising Chapter 2.1 Section B(1)(f) to add “(as accommodated in CompactConnect)” after “or National Provider Identifier (NPI).”

G. Thornton asked for a motion to propose an amendment to the ASLP-IC Rule on Data Set Reporting Requirements Chapter 2.1 Section B(1)(f) to add the parenthetical, “(as accommodated in CompactConnect)” after “or National Provider Identifier (NPI);” and forward the proposed amendment to the ASLP-IC Executive Committee.

**Motion:** T. Cranfill moved to propose an amendment to the ASLP-IC Rule on Data Set Reporting Requirements Chapter 2.1 Section B(1)(f) to add the parenthetical, “(as accommodated in CompactConnect)” after “or National Provider Identifier (NPI);” and forward the proposed amendment to the ASLP-IC Executive Committee. M. Zagarella seconded the motion. All delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

G. Thornton opened discussion of development of rules developing staggered terms, adverse action reporting requirements, mediation and dispute requirements/procedures. The committee reviewed draft rules other compact commissions are considering addressing these concerns. The Committee agreed to table future discussion and development of these rules until the August meeting.
