Welcome/Call to Order

- G. Thornton called the Rules Committee (Committee) meeting to order at 3:02 PM ET.

Roll Call

- K. Buckhout called the roll.

Review and Adoption of Revised Agenda

- G. Thornton asked if there were any questions about the agenda and asked for a motion to adopt the revised agenda.
- **Motion:** M. Zagarella moved to adopt the revised Rules Committee agenda. T. Cranfill seconded the motion. All Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

Review and Adopt Minutes

- G. Thornton asked if there were any questions about the March 12, 2026, meeting minutes. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to adopt the minutes.
- **Motion:** M. Zagarella moved that the Rules Committee adopt the March 12, 2026, meeting minutes. T. Cranfill seconded the motion. Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

Discuss and Adopt Rules on Dispute Resolution, Joint Investigations, Postgraduate Professional Experience, National Exam, and Military Identification

- Dispute Resolution
 - T. Cranfill asked for examples of situations where this rule would be needed. N. Kalfas shared the situation where a member state believes another member state did not submit adverse actions in a timely manner.
 - **Motion:** T. Cranfill moved that the Rules Committee recommend the draft rules to the Executive Committee for further action. M. Zagarella seconded the motion. Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.

- Joint Investigations
 - The Committee discussed ensuring that any new definitions are included in the rule on definitions and are consistent among rules and statutory language.

 - Military Identification
 - The Committee originally developed a policy. The Executive Committee asked for a rule to be drafted to address the failure to submit required documentation.
 - **Motion:** M. Zagarella moved that the Rules Committee recommend the draft rules to the Executive Committee for further action. T. Cranfill seconded the motion. Delegates voted in favor and the motion carried.
