Welcome/Call to Order

- G. Thornton called the Rules Committee (Committee) meeting to order at 3:11 PM ET.

Roll Call

- C. Covert-ByBee called the roll.

Review and Adoption of Agenda

- G. Thornton asked if there were any questions about the agenda and asked for a motion to adopt the agenda.
- **Motion:** M. Zagarella moved to adopt the Rules Committee Agenda. V. Pullins seconded the motion. All delegates voted in favor, and the motion carried.

Review and Adopt Minutes

- G. Thornton asked if there were any questions about the June 11, 2026, meeting minutes. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to adopt the minutes.
- **Motion:** M. Zagarella moved that the Rules Committee adopt the June 11, 2026, meeting minutes. V. Pullins seconded the motion. All delegates voted in favor, and the motion carried.

Discussion of Compact Privilege Expiration and Updating FAQs

- G. Thornton provided background information on States that have a renewal grace period post-expiration and how that impacts compact privileges. In short, the compact privilege is based on expiration date of the home state license as outlined in both the model legislation and as part of the CompactConnect database design. N. Kalfas provided legal background on the issue. The Committee discussed the issue and decided to formulate language within the FAQs to explain to licensees and privilege holders the importance of ensuring their home state is renewed and that the new expiration date is reflected in the CompactConnect database prior to renewing any compact privileges. G. Thornton called for a motion to send the draft language to the Executive Committee for approval.
- **Motion:** M. Zagarella moved to send the draft FAQ to the Executive Committee for approval. V. Pullins seconded the motion. All delegates voted in favor, and the motion carried.

Public Comment and Adjournment

- G. Thornton opened the meeting for public comment. No members of the public commented.
- G. Thornton recommended that Rules Committee Meetings be suspended until after the Annual Business Meeting in October, unless pressing business arises.
